

## MAY FLOWERS

(To bring to the June tea!)

May is my favorite month! Let's welcome it with a colorful array of flower blocks. Use whatever color is in your stash for the flower. We'll do a white background to bring out the colors. You will need a small block of green for the leaves and a 2 in. square to contrast your flower color.

To make a finished 9 in. block cut:

From the white:

A - One 2 x 3 1/2 in.

B - One 2 in. square

E - Two 3 7/8 in. squares - cut each diagonally to make 4 pieces

F - Three 3 1/2 in. squares

From your flower color:

D - One 3 7/8 in. square - cut diagonally to make 2 pieces

G - One 3 1/2 in. square

From a coordinating or contrasting fabric from your flower color:

This is the "bud" of the flower

C - One 2 in. square

From green

H - One 3 7/8 in. square - cut diagonally to make 2 pieces

Follow the diagram carefully for proper placement. Alternate pressing blocks in the rows toward the center and away from the center so they lock easily when sewing the three rows together.

REMINDER: Do not trim block.
