

WHICH WAY TO DUBLIN?

We are all a little Irish in March no matter what our DNA, just for the fun of it! This month's block is green and white flying geese. They all seem to point in different directions, forcing us to ask, just which way IS Dublin? Have fun with this block!

To make a finished 10 in. block cut:

From white:

A – Eight 3 3/8 in. blocks

From green:

B – Eight 3 3/8 in. blocks

Cut both green and white 3 7/8 in. squares across diagonally. Sew one white to one green to make 16 blocks. Press half toward dark and half toward light, this will make it easier to “nest” blocks together.

Trim dog ears. When you sew next set as per the diagram, again, press half in one direction and half in another. This ability to nest makes the block so much easier and accurate.

Sew blocks together as per diagram below.

REMINDER: Do not trim block.
