

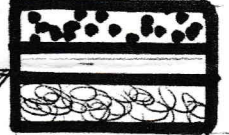
APRIL

MEADOW BLOCK

(By C. Yoder)

Fabric - Use any scrappy prints and white

- Cut - 8 rectangles - 2 1/2" by 5" - of assorted whites
- 8 squares ---- 2 1/2" by 2 1/2"- of white
- 4 stripes ----- 1" by 5"



- 1 - Sew a white 1" by 5" stripe between two different print rectangles.
- 2 - Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each white square.
- 3 - Place two white squares on opposite corners of each unit. Right sides together. Sew on marked lines and trim to 1/4". Compare yours to drawing. Press open.
- 4 - Arrange 4 units in two rows of two, rotating them as shown. Join into rows - press seam allowances in opposite directions. Join rows and press in ONE direction.

FINISHED BLOCK SIZE - 9 1/2" square
