

CACTUS IN BLOOM

1. Make a copy of pattern for paper piecing.
2. Fabric colors – use a variety of reds in different values
- 3 Background – any white
4. After piecing, the block should measure 8” by 8”.
5. Cutting - These sizes will be enough to cover it's area. Label the pieces as you cut so they don't get mixed up.

Background cut---

From reds cut---

for #2 and #13 -cut – 3”by 9” rectangles

for #10 cut – 2 1/2” by 6 1/4” piece

#8 and #9 -cut – 3”by 7” rectangles

#11 cut – 3”by 9” piece

1 -cut 3”by3” square

6 cut – 2 1/4” by 5” piece

4 and #5 -cut – 2 3/4” by 5 1/4” pieces

7 cut - 3” by 6 3/4” piece

2 cut - 3” by 2” piece

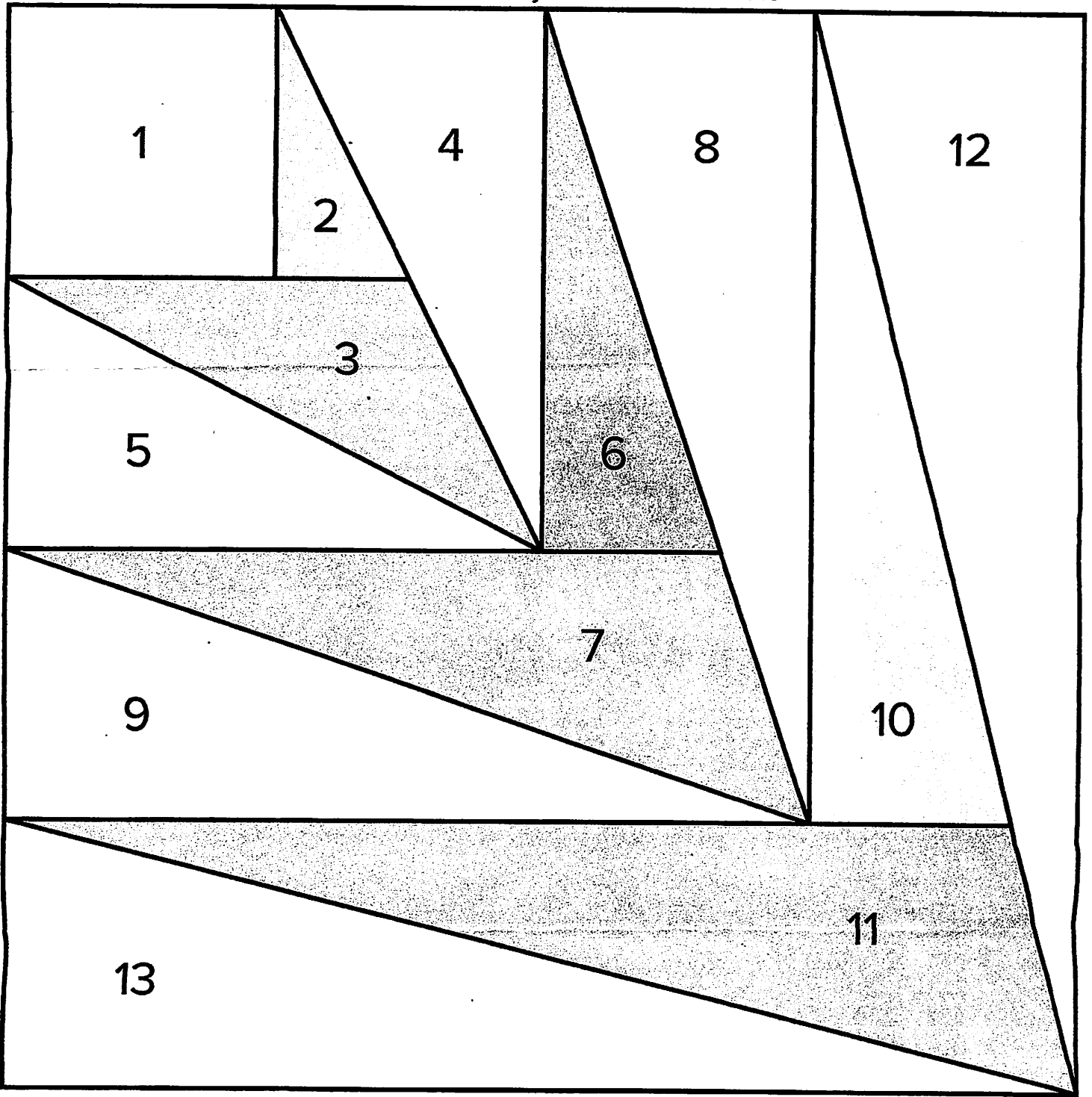
3 cut – 3” by 4 3/4”

Stitch in order #1 thru #13 onto the paper. Follow any paper foundation piecing directions.

Shorten stitch length to aid paper removal ,but DO NOT REMOVE PAPER

Be sure to cover the 1/4”seam allowance. Trim on the outside line

Use a dry iron.



seam allowance
